II. Cedar Park Principal Introduction- Shannon Anderson

- Shannon wanted to reach out as a new principle in Beaverton
- She is getting to know the community and thought it would be good to branch out to the feeder schools to answer any questions parents may have
- She wants to ease the transition and help lessen anxiety
- The Cedar Park PTC does one fundraiser every year at the end of September. Last year they raised \$50k for a student body of 1000.
- Looking for 2 people to run the fundraiser and the parent volunteer coordinator.
- Question: Janelle Hosch with the Summa program moving out of Cedar Park what options will be available to students that do not want to go to Meadow Park. Answer: Teachers are equipped to assess the kids and honors level curriculum will be brought in.
- Noted that Cedar Park is also an MYP- Middle Year Program which sets students up for IB International Baccalaureate.
- Question: Do you anticipate establishing some additional transitional programs? Answer: Not currently. Cedar Park has approximately 65 students that work with incoming 6th graders at the 6th grade picnic to learn the survival skills for middle school. There is also a fall open house.
