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PARLIMENTARY PROCEDURE - QUICK TIPS!

Making a Motion: If a vote is needed, it should be phrased like this: “I move that _____,” such as “I move that we spend \$700 for buses for the Biztown field trip.”

The motion must be “seconded” before a vote can happen meaning that one other person supports it. Simply say, “Second.”

Casting your vote: All PTC members have the right to vote.

You are a PTC member if you have a student at Cedar Mill or if you are part of the Cedar Mill staff.

Votes are typically cast with a verbal “Aye” for yes or “Nay” for no. If the votes are close, we may use a raise of hands.

PTC VOCABULARY:

Art Literacy: PTC-run program where volunteers teach a monthly art lesson in classrooms.

BSD: Beaverton School District

Dine-out: Fundraiser where restaurants give a % of sales back to the PTC.

Fun Run: PTC Annual Fundraiser where kids run laps and are sponsored by friends and family. Happening on 9/20 and the goal is to raise \$63,000.

Grade Level Parents: Volunteers (one/grade level) to serve as a resource/answer questions.

Green Team: Parent/educator/student group that works to implement ecologically sound practices in their school

Lapping Lumberjacks Running Club: Before-school, twice-weekly running club open to all students.

Passport Club: Monthly program that quizzes 3rd-5th graders on geography.

PledgeStar: Online fundraising program for collecting Fun Run pledges. See www.pledgestar.com/cedarmill/

Open Items/Opens: Section of our meetings dedicated to hearing from the community.

Treats and Talk: Once-monthly open conversation with the principal.

Work Party: Volunteer opportunity to complete projects for teachers making copies, etc. Thursday mornings.
